#### A Note from Our Pastor:

Dear Cradock Family:

We live in troubled times and it seems that adversity follows us everywhere! I believe we are in the last times before the Lord Jesus Christ comes again to receive the church (true believers). So how do we withstand the Devil when we are bombarded everywhere we turn? Two scriptures come to mind that remind us that Jesus is still in control and watching over us.

The first is Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and our strength, an ever-present help in trouble." The devastating earthquake that made landfall in Haiti a few years ago killed nearly 200,000 people. For a minister that was there, tells the story of a woman standing beside the road holding a baby in her arms. She said: "I lost my son...he died in the rubble.' She was asked: "Did you get to bury him?" "No, no chance; his body was crushed in the rubble; I just had to throw him away." As she got on a bus with her backpack, which had a side pocket with a Bible in it and as she got on the bus to take her to a safer place, she was heard saying, "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble..." I wonder if we would have the same faith in such an awful experience like this woman who had just lost her son??

The second scripture is 1 Peter 1:6-7: "In all this you greatly rejoice, through now for a little while you may have to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. These have come so that the proven genuineness of you faith - of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire - may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed." Jesus reminds us that even though our lives are filled with trials and adversity, we are not alone, and He is always with us. Jesus also reminds us that in every situation, He is not only there but has the strength to give us and to bring glory out of adversity. The question is: Can we hold on and allow Him to carry us through these situations because He already has a solution if we will only put the problem in His hands and let Him take care of us.

I want to encourage you to keep Cradock Baptist in your prayers as the Lord calls home our members, that leaves fewer of us to carry on the ministry. Giving is down, so any extra you can give to the support of Cradock's ministry will be greatly appreciated.

The current status of the steeple is in the hands of the Brotherhood Mutual and the contractor. Hope to get a better idea of progress by the end of the week. Keep us in your prayers and remember the Lord has really shined on Cradock Baptist, by providing the necessary finances to take care of the heating and air conditioning of the sanctuary. 




